The Green Breeze Green Living Fair is intended to inform people of all ages how they can live healthier lives and help the environment at the same time by using eco-friendly products and services. 100 exhibitors will be on hand providing seminars, product sampling and eco-friendly organic and green products in a family-friendly environment, including activities for children.

We are pleased to be partnering this year with the Birmingham Principal Shopping District's "Day on the Town," which attracts approximately 10,000 people.

## 2010 Green Breeze Rules and Guidelines:

- **GREEN BREEZE** will be held on Saturday, July 24, 2010, 9:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m. Exhibitors will be located on Old Woodward between Brown and Merrill Streets, and on Merrill going west from Old Woodward. Rain or shine! **Set up on Saturday, July 24, 6:00 a.m.**
- **REQUESTS FOR SPACE:** Space requests will not be confirmed without a signed application and full payment.
- **ELIGIBILITY:** The Community House reserves the right to determine if a company or product is eligible for exhibiting. All applicants will be reviewed and sent written confirmation of status. Exhibitors will only be permitted to exhibit and sell what was submitted and accepted per application.
- **CANCELLATION:** Cancellation must be submitted in writing by the exhibitor. In the event of an exhibitor cancellation, 50% of the exhibitor fee will be refunded before June 15, 2010. No refund will be made after June 15, 2010. No refund will be given due to the cancellation of the event by, an Act of God, local authorities, or a weather related incident.
- **SALES TAX:** Exhibitors are responsible for collection of 6% Michigan sales tax.
- **PERMITS:** All exhibitors must obtain a "peddler's" license from the Birmingham Clerk's Office (248.644.1800). Permits must be obtained by the exhibitor at least 48 hours prior to beginning of event.
- **INSURANCE:** Exhibitors are responsible for their own property. The Community House, Green Breeze and the City of Birmingham will not be responsible for damage to property or displays.
- **HEALTH DEPARTMENT:** Any Exhibitor giving away or selling food in his/her booth is responsible for all health permits, rules, regulations, etc. All food/beverage vendors must have Oakland County Health Department approval and are responsible for meeting all city/state resale licensing requirements. Whether selling or sampling food, all utensils, plates, etc. must be biodegradable.
- **DISPLAYS:** Exhibitors must bring tents (none will be provided). All tents must be weighted for safety and weather conditions and will be checked by the Fire Marshal upon set up. No staking is permitted. Exhibitors are responsible for setting them up and tearing them down, as well as tables, chairs and all set up equipment.
- **DISPLAY LOCATIONS:** The Community House reserves the right to make any logistical changes as deemed necessary and in the best interest of the event. In the event an exhibitor is relocated, it will be to a comparable space.
- **DISPLAY RESTRICTIONS:** All inventory, product and display materials must be contained within your designated space. No signage, or display material will be allowed outside of your designated space, and must not interfere with the street or sidewalks due to fire regulations. Distribution of product and literature is strictly limited to the confines of exhibitor's booth space.
- **TRASH DISPOSAL:** All trash from your exhibit must be sorted and disposed of in the recycling bins located throughout the fair.
- **SOUND DEVICES:** Mechanical reproduction of sound or music is permitted, but must not be projected outside the confines of exhibitor's booth space. The sound must be at a volume so as not to disturb other exhibitors or guests.
