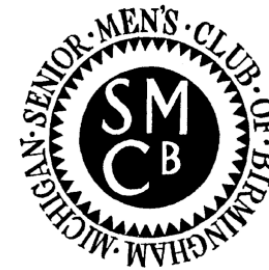

The Senior Men's Club of Birmingham, founded in April 1957, is an organization of senior men devoted to the promotion of fellowship, cultural interests and the rendering of service to the community.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must be of good moral character and fifty-five (55) years of age or more.

TO APPLY: Please complete the enclosed Application for Membership, including endorsements by two members, one as sponsor and one as alternate sponsor. (The Membership Committee will help obtain sponsors for you, if needed). Mail or deliver the completed Application to the Membership Chairman, Senior Men's Club of Birmingham, 380 South Bates St., Birmingham, MI 48009 (The Community House).

ASSOCIATE MEMBER STATUS: Applications approved by the Membership Committee are accorded Associate Member status. New Associates will receive a welcome letter and a Member Handbook listing current members, associates, Club officers, the Constitution and By-Laws and the Club's various activities and interest groups.

ORIENTATION: New Associates must attend an Associate Member Orientation meeting and must be present at the meeting scheduled for their induction into full membership. Orientation meetings, held three times a year preceding the regular Friday meetings, help acquaint new Associates with the Club's operations and activities.

INDUCTION: Associates awaiting induction will receive an offer of induction soon after attending the required Associate Orientation meeting. The induction must be completed within six months of the offer. Failure to do so may terminate the Associate's offer of full membership.

MEETINGS: Friday morning meetings start promptly at 10:30 a.m. Attendees should arrive and check-in between 9:30 – 10:25 a.m. The business session, speakers and/or programs conclude at 12:00 noon. An optional lunch at nominal cost follows until 12:30 p.m. A Discussion Session and Bridge follow at 12:45 p.m. Monthly speakers and programs for the Friday meetings are published in *The Reminder*. The only Club activity in August is an annual picnic to which both Members and Associates are invited.

CLUB ACTIVITIES: Associate Members are encouraged to attend the regular Friday morning meetings, to join one or more committees and to participate in all Club activities such as Bridge, Bowling, Camera Group, Classic Movies, Computer Group, Discussion Group, Golf, Investment Study, Reading Group and Special Events. Attendance at all events is optional.

DRESS CODE: The required attire for Friday morning Club meetings is a suit or sport coat, dress shirt (tie encouraged but optional), slacks and dress shoes. Exceptions, if any, will be announced in advance and published in *The Reminder*. The dress code for other events will depend on the nature of the event.

ANNUAL DUES: Dues are payable by January 1 each year. Notices will appear in *The Reminder*, the monthly publication of the Club. Applications accepted after August 31 are deemed paid for the next year.

QUESTIONS: Questions regarding the application process should be directed to the Membership Committee. After your application has been approved, questions should be directed to your sponsor or the Associate Members Committee.

When the Membership Committee approves your application for Associate Membership, you will be notified and your name will be added to the "Waiting List" for membership. New Associates must (i) attend an Associate Member Orientation as soon as possible (three are offered each year), and (ii) must be present at the meeting scheduled for their induction. The dress code for all Friday morning Club meetings is provided in the accompanying cover page. At induction, there is a \$15 initiation fee for the lapel pin and name tag.

Annual Dues are \$40. Please enclose your check payable to Senior Men's Club of Birmingham.
