# Welcome!

Dear Dancers and Parents,

Welcome, and thank you for joining us here at The Community House Dance Academy. For over 50 years the Dance Academy has provided a positive family environment to foster a love of dance in students of all ages. We believe in the value of the arts for all and that the friendships made and lessons learned will last a lifetime. Our interest isn't just building great dancers, it's cultivating great individuals. Concepts such as self-confidence, positive self-image, personal and social responsibility, respect, and community mindfulness are at the core of our mission to make each student not only their best dancer, but their very best self.

As a Liberal Arts studio we emphasize a balance of knowledge when it comes to dance. We encourage our dancers to study the different styles of dance without bias as they all have different roots and history. There is an aesthetic to tap instruction that varies greatly from ballet or jazz, yet no genre has "more" or "less" value than the others. Every dancer will find their own unique preferences, interests, and skills throughout their dance journey, and we strive to do everything we can to help them in their pursuits.

Our season runs from early September until June and culminates in a Spring Recital. The recital gives students the opportunity to practice performance skills and show off everything they have spent the year learning! We always love to see the sense of pride and accomplishment our students bring to the recital. We also feature a performance company, Encore, for those students who would like to grow their experience performing for different audiences. In addition, we produce a staging of the Nutcracker in the Fall with auditions open to all!

We once again thank you for joining us for another great season and hope you are as excited to get dancing as we are!



# Registration

Registration opens on August 1<sup>st</sup> for the Fall season, and January 1<sup>st</sup> for our Spring season. There is an annual \$15 per family registration fee. Registration can be completed online or by calling us at 248.644.5832.

### **Tuition and Fees**

The tuition number that is displayed online represents the total due per class per season. The Fall season runs September through the end of January, and the Spring season starts the first week of February and runs through June. When registering your child for class you have the option to pay the full tuition upon registration, or to enroll in a payment plan. The payment plan will require you to save a card on file and have the tuition charged in equal monthly instalments. Monthly withdrawals will be made on the first of the month. Tuition is \$55/month for 45 minute classes and \$60/month for hour long classes. Students enrolled in payment plans should please note that the registration fee will also be divided into their monthly payments. A \$20 nonrefundable fee will be charged for late payments or failed transactions due to insufficient funds.

### **Discounts**

We offer discounts for those dancers enrolled in multiple classes per season; the more classes you take the higher the discount! The discounts apply to single students, and are only valid for Dance Academy classes.

# Cancelations

In the event of inclement weather, The Dance Academy may cancel classes for the safety of students and staff. Cancelations may not necessarily follow school closures. If inclement weather forces more than two cancelations throughout the year, make-up classes will be scheduled by the instructor. Parents will be notified of cancelations via email at least one hour before class was scheduled to begin, and all closures will be posted on our Facebook page!

### **Credits and Refunds**

The Dance Academy abides by the credit and refund policy set forth by The Community House, which can be viewed below:

If you cannot attend a class, you may request a class credit before the class is to be held. Class credits may be applied toward the cost of any future Community House (TCH) class within the next year from the date of issuance of the credit.

A refund will only be given if TCH cancels a class or TCH is given a note, within one week from the scheduled class, from a doctor or medical facility stating the class taker had a medical emergency. TCH reserves the right to change class locations, schedules, fees, and instructors when necessary.

### Substitutes

All of our teachers are contracted and committed to teaching their scheduled classes for the year. That being said, life happens to us all and situations may arise where the scheduled instructor is physically unable to attend class. In that event the Dance Academy reserves the right to fill in an appropriate substitute for class. In the event an appropriate substitute cannot be found a makeup class will be scheduled with the regular instructor. Having a substitute teach class is not grounds for a refund, as stated in The Community House's refund policy.

# Attendance

Students are expected to be on time and ready to go at the start of every class. Excessive absences may lead to gaps in a student's knowledge. If a student misses an excessive amount of classes they may be prohibited form participation the spring recital.

# **Parent Viewing**

The Dance Academy does not allow parents in the classroom for several reasons. In our experience the presence of a parent forces the child to split their attention between the teacher and their parent and can inhibit learning. We want dance classes to be a complete educational experience, and part of that experience is allowing children to build relationships with their peers and instructors. We do offer show and tell dates throughout the session where parents will be invited into class for the last 15 minutes to view their child's progress and discover skills they are working on mastering!

### Bring a Friend to Dance Week

Two times a year we host a "bring a friend to dance week" where students are able to bring a friend along to class free of charge! Friends do not need to strictly adhere to the dress code, but please make sure they are prepared to have no street shoes in the studio (bare feet are okay!)

### **Contact and Communication**

Email is the primary form of contact and communication used by the Dance Academy, so please ensure that we have the proper email information for you on file! If you would like to contact a teacher personally please direct your inquiry through the Company Coordinator and they will get you in contact with your instructor. For the privacy of our staff we do not provide staff cell phone numbers.

### **Dress Code**

Students are expected to be dressed appropriately for every dance class. Specific class attire can be found below. For the safety purposes, students will not be allowed to wear jewelry other than small stud earrings. Street shoes are not permitted on the dance floor and parents should ensure that children do not wear their dance shoes outside. Shoe debris can be hazardous to dancers and decreases the life of the flooring.

Ballet Level 1, 1/2, 2, 3	Girls: Solid black leotard; pink footed ballet tights; pink leather full sole ballet shoes; hair in a bun.  Boys: White t-shirt; boys black tights; black leather full sole ballet shoes.
Ballet Level 4 and Up	Girls: Solid black leotard; pink footed or convertible ballet tights; pink canvas or leather split sole or full sole ballet shoes; hair in a bun.  Boys: White t-shirt; boys black tights; black canvas or leather split sole or full sole ballet shoes; dance belt.
Pointe	Black leotard; pink ballet tights; pointe or pre-pointe shoes; black ballet skirt okay; hair in a bun. No pop up shanks.
Jazz 1, 2, 2/3, 3	Girls: Tan slip-on jazz shoes; black leotard; pink or tan tights; black spandex shorts over tights okay; hair pulled back/out of face.  Boys: Black slip-on or lace-up jazz shoe; white or black t-shirt; black shorts, black jazz pants, or black exercise pants. No sweat pants or baggy pants
Jazz 4 and Above	Girls: Tan slip-on jazz shoes, foot paws, pirouettes, or bare feet; black leotard; pink or tan tights; black spandex shorts over tights is okay; hair pulled back/out of face.  Boys: Black slip-on or lace-up jazz shoe; white or black t-shirt; black shorts, black jazz pants, or black exercise pants. No sweat pants or baggy pants
Contemporary 1 and Above	Girls: Tan pirouettes or bare feet; black leotard; pink or tan tights; spandex shorts over tights okay; hair pulled back/out of face.  Boys: Tan pirouettes or bare feet; white or black t-shirt; black shorts, black jazz pants, or black exercise pants. No sweat pants or baggy pants.
Beginning Tap	Girls: Black Mary-Jane tap shoes or black lace-up tap shoes; any color leotard (skirted okay) or tank top; pink tights, black spandex shorts, black cropped legging, or black jazz pants (above the heel); hair pulled back/out of face.  Boys: Black lace-up tap shoes; white or black t-shirt; black shorts, black jazz pants, or black exercise pants. No sweat pants or baggy pants.
Tap 1 and Above	Girls: Black lace-up tap shoe; black leotard or tank top; pink or tan tights, black spandex shorts, black cropped legging, or black jazz pants (above the heel); hair pulled back/out of face.  Boys: Black lace-up tap shoe; white or black t-shirt; black shorts, black jazz pants, or black exercise pants. No sweat pants or baggy pants.
Adult Classes	Please adhere to the shoe guidelines listed in children's classes; however adults may feel free to make changes to the given attire.

# The Nutcracker

All students ages 7 and up are able to audition for our annual production of the Nutcracker! These auditions are open to dancers and performers from any studio so be sure to tell your friends to join you!

Auditions will be held on Saturday, September 30<sup>th</sup> and the schedule is as follows:

Ages 7-12 1:00-2:30 PM

Ages 13-15 2:00-3:30 PM

Ages 16-18 3:00-4:30 PM

Adults 4:00-5:30 PM

Dancers should be prepared to fill out some paperwork, participate in a barre and across the floor exercises, and learn a short routine to perform. Upon casting a formal rehearsal schedule will go out that details when students will be expected to be at rehearsal; for the most part rehearsals will run on Saturday afternoons. Tech rehearsal is December 12<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM, dress rehearsal is December 13<sup>th</sup> from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM, and the show is December 17<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 PM and 5:00 PM; these are mandatory for all dancers.

# **Spring Recital**

An annual event, the spring recital gives every student enrolled in a Dance Academy class the opportunity to perform! Dances and choreography will be developed and polished each week in class and will display the skills that the dancers have been learning throughout the year. The Spring Recital is wonderful event for dancers to feel the pride and accomplishment that comes with showcasing their talents for family and friends! The Spring Recital will be held on Saturday, June 23<sup>rd</sup> at the Groves Little Theatre with a dress rehearsal on the 22<sup>nd</sup>. An additional costume fee will be charged for each dance a child participates in; the costumes are theirs to keep and all our instructors are committed to doing what they can to keep costs down!

# Encore

For those dancers looking for more opportunities to perform and grow their dancing skills we do offer a Performance Company, Encore. Encore focuses on excellence in all styles of dance and believes in the importance of providing diverse performance opportunities for dancers. Encore will attend competitions when it is desired and requested by team members and coordinators, and will focus on several community and volunteer performances throughout the year. We are already excited for our dancers to participate in the "Bates Street Trick or Treat" Halloween event held right here at The Community House, as well as a Holiday Tour to different retirement communities within the area. For those interested in Encore the audition date is September 23<sup>rd</sup> with ages 8-12 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM and ages 13 & up 11:30 AM to 12:30 PM.

# **Additional Policies**

### **Student Care and Illness**

TCH is not responsible for student care before or after class. Students are not to be left at the studio for excessive time periods. We ask that parents of young children stay at the studio while class is in session.

A student, who is ill, must stay home if they are contagious, have a fever, excessive cough, or are vomiting.
