

Archaeological discoveries encouraged interest in classical antiquity. By mid-century artists began to turn from sentiment and nostalgia for a past golden age to examine the modern world and the issues current conditions raised.

ART FOR PROPAGANDA

Napoleon understood the power of art to shape how he was regarded. He favored classically-inspired art, as emperors and dictators often do, because it recalls the grandeur of the Roman Empire. His downfall inspired propaganda against him and a new nationalism in his former empire.


