MORNING CAMP CARE:

AFTER CAMP CARE:

We provide an After Camp Care program for our campers who attend afternoon camps and need to be picked up later than when their camps end. Campers will be engaged in fun games and crafts with our camp counselors.

After care is available starting at 3:00 pm and campers must be picked up by 5:30 pm. Campers being picked up after 5:30 pm will be charged a late fee of \$5 (at time of pick up) per every 10 minutes after 5:30 pm.

DROP OFF/PICK UP PROCEDURES:
